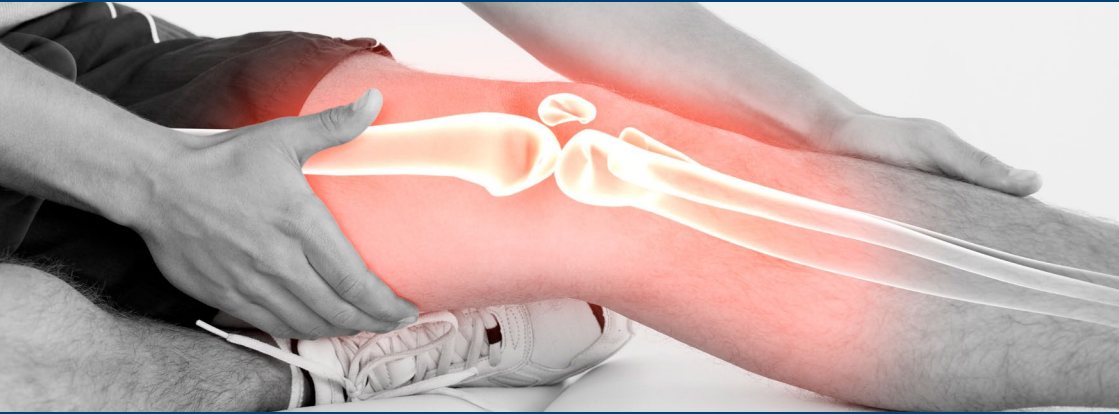

Dr. Scott Brumby is an Orthopaedic Surgeon at Wakefield Orthopaedic Clinic, Adelaide, Australia, specialising in primary and revision hip and knee arthroplasty.

He obtained his Orthopaedic Fellowship in 1999 after having completed a Ph.D. investigating the biomechanics of cemented hip arthroplasty in 1997. Dr Brumby was also awarded the Marjorie Hopper travelling fellowship, the Mark Jolly travelling fellowship and the Johnson and Johnson Joint Replacement Fellowship in Switzerland, Sweden & England. He has also studied at Harvard Medical School, USA.

Dr. Brumby has a strong interest in evidence-based surgery and is actively involved in reviewing data from the Australian Orthopaedic Association National Joint Replacement Registry and has been a regular member of the Arthroplasty Society of Australia surgeon review panel. He is actively involved in arthroplasty education and surgical training within Australia, the Asia Pacific region and internationally.

Customising knee replacements to each patient also allows Dr Brumby's patients to return to function and better quality of life.
