Respiratory and Sleep Lab Service

Stirling Hospital is pleased to announce the launch of a new and much-needed service for the community in the Adelaide Hills: a comprehensive respiratory service.

Adelaide Sleep and Respiratory Centre is proud to be providing this new service from the Hospital from July 2024, which will be led by Dr Khin Hnin and Dr Jared Anderson. Some of the tests available will be full lung function tests and spirometry which are both vital to assist with respiratory diagnosis.

Lung function testing is essential for diagnosing and managing various respiratory conditions such as asthma, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), and other lung-related illnesses. Spirometry, a fundamental component of this service, measures the volume and speed of air that can be inhaled and exhaled, offering critical insights into lung health. The full lung function test goes a step further, evaluating additional parameters to assist with the diagnosis and management of various respiratory pathology.

The introduction of these respiratory tests at Stirling Hospital represents a significant advancement in healthcare for our local community. Patients no longer need to travel out of the Adelaide Hills to access these essential diagnostics, ensuring more timely and convenient access to care. We are dedicated to enhancing the health and well-being of our community and introduction of this new service demonstrates our ongoing commitment to providing comprehensive, high-quality medical services close to home.
