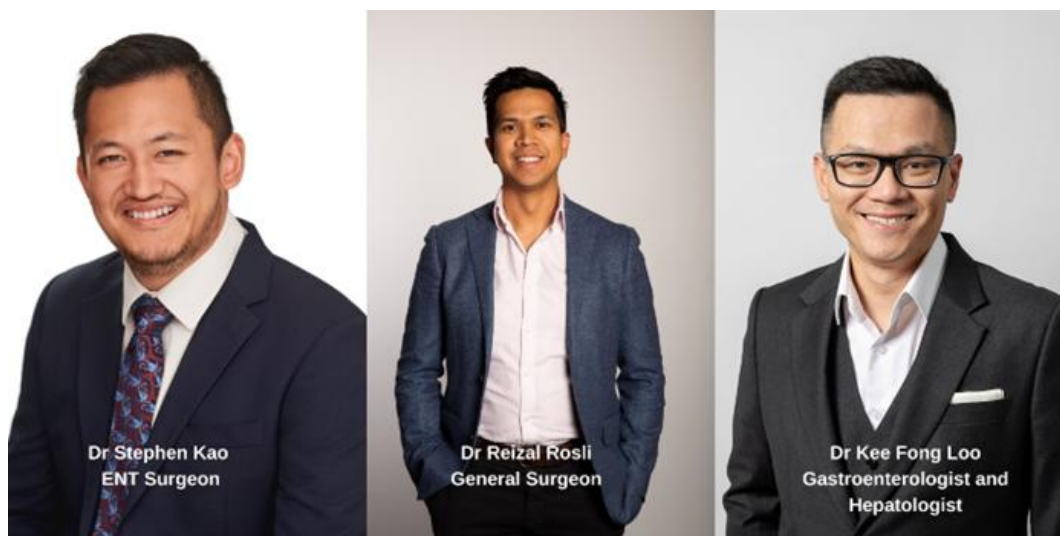
Brighter Health Marketing Campaign
